OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

Stick Man (Early Years Curriculum)

In our phonics sessions we will continue to learn new sounds and will be applying these to our reading and writing.

In our Maths sessions we will continue to work on recognising numbers and will then develop our knowledge of shape names and will learn how to make patterns. We will then work on talking about the size and weight of different objects, using words like 'heavy', 'light', 'big' and 'small'.

In Early Years, our pupils have the opportunity to choose the direction of their own learning, identifying new knowledge and skills they would like to work on week by week. So far the children have expressed an interest in learning more about fireworks, puppets (such as how to make them and how to create a puppet show), making a Stick Man and using musical instruments. Each week they will reflect on how their learning has gone so far and identify what they would like to learn next!
