Stick Man!

In English, we will be learning how to write instructions and letters. We will continue with our daily Reading Skills sessions and phonics sessions. We will also be writing stories linked to Stick Man and winter poetry as part of our writing skills sessions.

In Maths, we will be developing our addition and subtraction skills, as well as working on shape and measurement.

Our Science lessons will focus on seasonal change, as well as animals and their habitats. Geography will be closely linked to this, as we will be learning about hot and cold countries, focusing on countries close to the Equator and the South and North Poles.

In DT, we will be looking at different ways to join materials and in RE we will be looking at what Christians learn about God from the Bible.

Our PSHE sessions will focus on relationships and we will be talking about what makes a good friend and how to resolve problems when we fall out.
