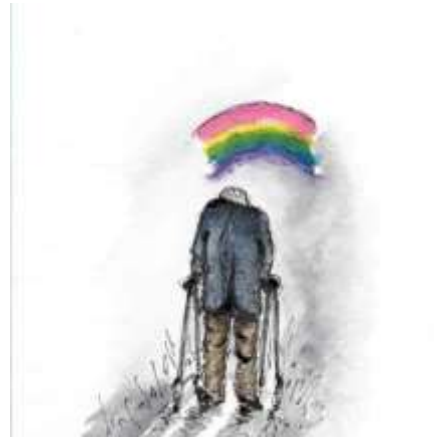


Dear children, parents & carers,
