Term 3 – Primary Schools Update

This term's theme is all about travelling safely in a car. During the colder weather you will probably find that more pupils will travel to school by car. This is a timely reminder to your school community of the importance of wearing seatbelts and correctly fitted child restraints.

With the additional car journeys, there will inevitably be additional parking problems and congestion outside schools. Reducing congestion will make the environment outside your school both healthier and safer.

Measures such as park and stride and walking bus can be established at individual schools with the assistance of the sustainable travel department within Lincolnshire County Council.
