For children who are further up the school, or who join us part way through their school journey, we realise that it may not be possible to experience all of the 30 things on the list before they leave us, but we will do our best to complete as many as possible in the time we have available.

Out 30 Things are:

- 6. Make a puppet
- 7. Grow something to eat
- 8. Learn about a group of Christians engaged in social action today
- 9. Make a musical instrument
- 10. Dress up as your favourite book character
- 11. Make a pizza
- 12. Visit a museum
- 13. Learn a French song
- 14. Plan a party
- 15. Play a board game and design your own
- 16. Walk on the beach/through a forest



- 17. Vote in a school election
- 18. Help to raise funds for a local or national charity
- 19. Visit a place of worship
- 20. Create and display a piece of art
- 21. Decorate a Christmas Tree
- 22. Take on a position of responsibility
- 23. Send an email
- 24. Put on a performance
- 25. Serve a meal
- 26. Take part in a community project
- 27. Visit a new city
- 28. Interview someone
- 29. Visit a cathedral
- 30. Work with/visit another LAAT school

Throughout each academic year, we will give the children opportunities to complete some of the activities. E.g., all pupils will have the chance to visit the pantomime this term. There is no expectation that children complete these activities at home, but if you would like ideas of activities you can do with your children, we recommend National Trusts 50 things to do before you're 11¾.
