Dear Parents/Carers

For Spring Term 1 we have planned a visit to Lincoln Museum for an exciting trip with the other Year 2 children from Whaplode. The trip links with our learning in History where we have learnt about Roman Britain. The trip will take place on Friday 19th January 2024.

Our plan for the day will be as follows –

- Children **must** arrive at school on time on this day as we are being collected as soon as school starts.
- We will complete the following activities across the day:
 - Museum Investigation
 - Life in Lindum Colonia
 - Life in the Roman Army
- If your child has a packed lunch, please send this in as normal. If your child has school dinners, this will be swapped to a packed lunch which Willoughby Foods will provide.
- We aim to leave Lincoln Museum around 2pm in the hope to be back in time for a usual end of day pick up. If there are any delays, we will be in contact via email on the day if a later pick up is needed.

We require children to wear their full uniform for the day please. Blue jumpers or cardigans are essential to ensure the children are easily visible to members of staff. Due to the time of year of the trip please ensure children have coats to wear during movements between venue and coach. All children will need a disposable, named drinks bottle that can be thrown in the bin once empty. Please do not send in fizzy drinks. There is no need to send a snack with them.

To supplement the cost of the trip we are asking for a contribution of £10.00. In accordance with the school's prospectus, all school journeys and visits will generate requests for parental/carer contributions. If sufficient contributions are not forthcoming, the activity may be cancelled and a suitable in school activity sourced instead. If pupil illness takes affect after a trip has been paid for and the pupil is unable attend the trip, then the school will not be able to offer refunds to parents/carers for the trip. Please note that the school has already subsidised this trip in order to bring down the cost therefore it is important that those who are able to contribute do so, in order for the trip to go ahead.

All payments must be paid for via ParentMail. If you are having troubles with this, please contact the school office where we will be happy to help.
